In connection with Alamo colleges, the Alamo Academies program provides education, experience, and job opportunities for high school students looking to advance their future before high school graduation. Students can earn up to 30+ hours of college semester credit leading to a certificate of completion.

Judson High School has one of the highest cohorts of students enrolled in the program in the region, with 41 students attending either San Antonio College or St. Philip College in the morning, then coming back to campus and finishing their high school classes in the afternoon. Students can focus on aerospace engineering, information technology, advanced technology and manufacturing, diesel technology, or health professions.


Judson ISD Give Back Night at the San Antonio Spurs Game! Go Spurs Go!



AT THE JOINT SUBCOMMITTEE HEARING: COMBATING RANSOMWARE ATTACKS

On Wednesday, September 27, Dr. Lacey Gosch, JISD Assistant Superintendent of Technology, testified in front of the United States House of Representatives Subcommittee on Cybersecurity, Information Technology, and Government Innovation, and the Subcommittee on Economic Growth, Energy Policy, and Regulatory Affairs.

Seen as an expert in her field, her goal was to "share through testimony the effects of a cybersecurity incident, specifically Ransomware, on public schools." She was a critical asset in making sure the district survived the ransomware attack in the summer of 2021. With her leadership and the swift actions of the technology department, they were able to build back better and more technologically advanced.

"Judson ISD is in an optimal position technologically to prevent and mitigate future attacks,"

Gosch said in her written testimony.




JUDSON ISD UNITED WAY CAMPAIGN HAS BEGUN!
