Eagles continue to support a united school and drug-free life.







#### LITIGATION AGAINST MIKE MORATH

A lawsuit against Texas Education Commissioner Morath was filed by several Texas school districts. The lawsuit is related to the fairness of the new rules that have been recommended to determine the 2023 A-F Accountability Ratings.

Last week, a judge granted a temporary injunction in favor of the school districts, blocking the state from implementing the new standards to determine this year's accountability ratings. This means that the Commissioner is prohibited from releasing the 2023 A-F results until a new court order is issued. The TEA intends to file an appeal to this decision.

The delay in the results has not and will not affect the quality of education that we provide as a district. We are committed to providing a first-rate education to all our students, with or without state ratings.




