DISTRICT REQUIRED TRAINING COURSES

Each year, the state requires school districts to train all employees on the following topics:

- 1. Cybersecurity Awareness
- 2. Bloodborne Pathogen Exposure Prevention
- 3. Bullying Recognition and Response
- 4. Child Abuse: Mandatory Reporting
- 5. Sexual Harassment: Statt to Staff
- 6. Sexual Harassment: Student Issues and Response
- 7. Student Mental Health: Awareness, Intervention, and Referral
- 8. Youth Suicide: Awareness, Prevention, and Postvention
- 9. Workplace Injury Prevention

All current active employees have been enrolled in the above courses. All courses are to be completed by October 31, 2023. Courses are accessible through Eduphoria Strive. Here is a training video showing how to access and complete the required courses via the JISD Intranet through the JISD portal.
