- Expands the visibility of the library.

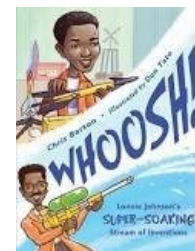
Library programming criteria:

- Relation to library collections, resources, exhibits and programs.

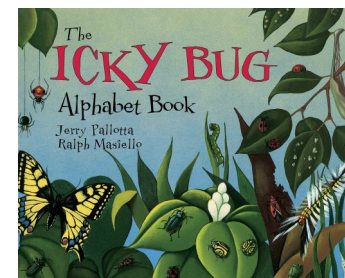
