#### Welcome and Introductions (10 minutes)

- Introductions of committee members, roles and responsibilities
- Superintendent Dr. Rob Fields opened the meeting at 6:02 pm. He discussed our district's exemption from SHAC per our District of Innovation Plan.
- The Board of Trustees adopted the Dol Plan Renewal in March 2023 that included an exemption from SHAC. The following month, the Board of Trustees adopted BDF Local Policy exempting the district from SHAC requirements.
  - BDF Local Policy: In accordance with the District's innovation plan, the District shall be exempt from forming a School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) and all the duties associated with the SHAC. The District health coordinator shall be appointed to collaborate with the District and campus improvement committees to obtain feedback regarding health-related curriculum, food service, budget, and other related items.

#### District of Innovation Amendment (10 minutes)

- Related to HB 114 DAEP Placement and E-cigarettes
- Deputy Superintendent Ms. Davis shared the Dol Amendment that was adopted by the Board of
  Trustees on September 21, 2023 related to E-Cigarettes and a mandatory DAEP placement. The
  Board of Trustees adopted the Dol Amendment that exempts the district from mandatory DAEP
  placement for students who are in possession of e-cigarettes with nicotine. Rather, they will receive
  a suspension for the first time offense. However, students who are found in possession of ecigarettes with THC will still receive the mandatory DAEP placement. All the details are in the Dol
